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# Social Audit: A Need

A social audit is an official evaluation of an organization's involvement in social responsibility projects or endeavors. Social Audit can bring social accountability to the functioning of the government or its departments and civil society organizations. Another aim is to make a judgment of the material and monetary shortfalls, if any, between the needs of the community and the assets that are available for the development of the local society. It is also to provide information needed to improve the effectiveness of programs designed to enhance community development. It has attained immense popularity in recent time throughout the globe. It is an instrument to make the functionaries of the institutions/ departments of the government and make them socially accountable. It also ensures an in-depth scrutiny and analysis of the working of any public utility vis-à-vis its social relevance. In that context, an educational institution, being run on Governmental/Public funding, has the same type of accountability to the neighbouring society and its needs, and by doing a social audit it establishes a kind transparency with the society and also builds up a kind of trust in the eyes of the community. The advantages of social audits include the following:

- To uphold transparency, accountability and participation of community in college development activities.
- To provide community an opportunity to scrutinize the college development works.
- To encourage participation of stake-holders and sharing their values.
- To ensure that works are done as per norms and the errors, if any, are rectified during implementation of the activity or project.
- To strengthen the community monitoring and thereby sustain the community ownership.
- To maintain a cordial relation between community and the college.
- To ensure proper utilization of resources
- To enhance the college's image in the eyes of the public

Keeping in view the afore cited need and advantages of Social Audit, Swahid Peoli Phukan College, Namti organized a general meeting inviting civil society members of greater Namti area on 29-01-2022. The meeting was presided over by Dr. Dhrubajyoti Nath, Principal of the college. Dr. Shahiuz Zaman Ahmed, RUSA Coordinator of the college gave a presentation before the civil society members on the execution of the RUSA fund followed by a discussion. In the meeting the college authority expressed its interest to go for a social audit of the RUSA projects received and executed by Swahid Peoli Phukan College, Namti and formed the following Social Audit Committee.

# About the College:

Swahid Peoli Phukan College, Namti emerged as the milestone in the field of higher education in greater Namti under the auspices of the founder Principal Sri Durgadhar Bora and a group of visionary persons in 1970. The College has a history of more than fifty years of dedicated service towards creating awareness in the neighborhood and developing infrastructure and facilities for imparting education in this historic region.

This institution was established in a rural ambience and has withstood the test of time. During these eventful years, Swahid Peoli Phukan College has carved a niche for itself in the field of higher education with special emphasis on need of the hour. In 2015 the college was re-accredited by the NAAC and was enlisted by *Rashtriya Uchchatar Siksha Abhiyan* (RUSA) as one of its beneficiary colleges. In 2016, RUSA sanctioned Rs 2.0 crore (two crore) to the college for its infrastructural development and released the amount in three phases.

# Details of Schemes of RUSA:

In 2016, Rashtriya Uchchatar Siksha Abhiyan (RUSA) sanctioned Swahid Peoli Phukan College an amount of Rs. Two Crores only vide Email from Santanu Baishya dated 20<sup>th</sup> March 2016 at 11:48 am under the heading 'RUSA Infrastructure Grants to colleges. The RUSA authority also instructed to spend the amount under following three heads.

The sanctioned amount was released to the college in three installments of Rs. 50 Lacs, Rs. 100 Lacs and Rs 50 Lacs vide letter nos. ASHEC(RUSA)47/2016/255-264 dated 28/12/2016; . ASHEC(RUSA)/Release of fund/47/2016/915-A dated 09/04/2018 and ARUSA/PIM/234/2019/1631 dated 11<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

# **RUSA Fund Execution Procedure:**

The RUSA execution committee of the college followed the following procedures in implementing the RUSA grants:

- 1. Proper detailed project reports (DPR) were prepared by a reputed registered architect.
- 2. All the DPRs are discussed and verified by the RUSA Project Monitoring Unit of the college.
- 3. All the DRRs were verified by the PWD (Building) Executive and Superintendent Engineers and formal approval letters were obtained.
- 4. Online and offline tenders published in two daily newspapers were invited by the college authority for the designated works under RUSA.
- 5. All the tenders were scrutinized by the screening committee and on the recommendation of the screening committee the RUSA PMU of the college finalized the contractors and vendors.
- 6. The selected contractors and vendors were offered work orders by the Principal of the college.
- 7. Seeing the progress and completion of the of the RUSA works the payment was made to the Contractors and vendors only through Public Finance Management System (PFMS) deducting appropriate GST and Labour CESS (where applicable).
- 8. Deducted GST and Labour Cess were deposited to the government account as per rules and regulations.
- 9. The RUSA office of the college has meticulously kept records of Assets Registrar, Issued and dispatch letters.

- 10. RUSA project reports are uploaded on the site of Project Monitoring System for verification of the RUSA office, Assam.
- 11. Progress reports of the works were sent to the RUSA office Assam time to time.

# Details of Works Done:

The RUSA execution committee of the college has successfully spent the following items as per RUSA guidelines. Entire sanctioned amount of the RUSA project was deposited in the dedicated Savings bank account of RUSA i.e. 'Swahid Peoli Phukan College RUSA Fund' opened at State Bank of India, Chapangani Branch, Namti. The Bank account No is 35720365282. The account is jointly operated by the Principal, Swahid Peoli Phukan College, Namti who is the Chairman of the RUSA Project Monitoring Unit and the RUSA Coordinator of the college. All the bill amount of the RUSA works have been transferred to the contractors and vendors trough the Public Finance Management System (PFMS). All the records related to the RUSA works have been uploaded in the site of Project Monitoring System, RUSA Assam and the documents kept in the RUSA office in a systematic manner. Moreover, the important documents related to financial transactions and other official orders have also been kept in digital format. All the financial transactions are reflected in the dedicated RUSA Cash Book.

# Supervision and comments of the RUSA Officials:

The execution of the RUSA works are monitored and supervised by the RUSA officials, Assam

from time to time. At Swahid Peoli Phukan College the RUSA Managing Director, Assam and other officials also visited the college several times to see the progress of the works. The officials found the works done at Swahid Peoli Phukan College satisfactory. In the report the RUSA

officials made the following head wise observations:

### **New Construction:**

488 sq. mt. carpet area built under New Construction in G+2 structure having 10 nos. of classroom, 3 nos. of Hall classroom with 6 nos. of toilet units for both boys and Girls. Swahid Peoli Phukan College is the first college in Assam under RUSA who had done e-tendering for New Construction in the month of Nov. 2017.

### **Renovation:**

- 1. 7,984.8 sq. mt. of area has been renovated under Renovation of Academic building,
- Administrative building, Auditorium of the college. 26 nos. of rooms are renovated by changing roofs, painting, floor tiles, Windows, Door, Aluminum partition and internal electrification.
- 2. 187 sq. mt. area of girls' hostel renovated which includes 6 nos. of room and 2 nos. of Toilet units.

3. 146 sq.mt. of Classroom building renovated which includes 6 nos. of classrooms.

### **Equipments:**

- 1. 2662 nos. of books have been procured.
- 2. 39 nos. of Sports equipment procured which includes 1 no. of Outdoor synthetic Badminton Court.
- 3. 88 nos. of computer has been procured with all accessories.
- 4. 1715 nos. of Lab equipments have been procured for 7 nos. of departments.

### **Financial Observation:**

- 1. Cash book and Pass book tally.
- 2. Forest royalty and Labour Cess have not been deducted earlier. College is advised to deduct the same from the final bill of payment to be made to the contractor.

# Observations and Suggestions of the Social Audit Committee:

The Social Audit Committee formed on 29th January, 2022 visited the college and audit the

financial and physical execution of the RUSA Projects of the college on the 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2022. The committee checked in detail the financial transactions of the College did for procuring the assets. The committee unanimously makes the following

observations on the RUSA activities of the college:

### **Procedural Observations:**

- 1. Proper and detailed project reports (DPR) were prepared by a reputed registered architecture.
- 2. Meetings of RUSA Project Monitoring Unit of the college were held at regular intervals.
- 3. Proper approval letters were obtained for renovation and new construction projects from the PWD (Building) Executive and Superintendent Engineers.
- 4. Online and offline tenders publishing in two daily news papers were invited by the college authority for the designated works under RUSA.
- 5. All the tenders were scrutinized by the screening committee and on the recommendation of the screening committee the RUSA PMU of the college finalized the selected contractors and vendors.
- 6. The selected contractors and vendors were offered work orders by the Principal of the college.

# **Observation on Financial Management:**

- Seeing the progress and completion of the of the RUSA works the payment was made to the Contractors and vendors only through Public Finance Management System (PFMS) deducting appropriate GST and Labour CESS (where applicable). No cash transaction was made.
- 2. Deducted GST and Labour Cess were deposited to the government account as per rules and regulations.
- 3. As per RUSA rules the college could have spent 2% of the allocated fund i.e. Rs 4 lacs for miscellaneous purposes. But the college has spent only Rs. 13 thousand under this category and rest of the amount i.e. Rs. 3.87 lacs have been utilized for the development works. This is highly praiseworthy and example of financial transparency.

# **Observation on Record Keeping:**

1. The RUSA office of the college has meticulously kept records of Assets Registrar, Cash Book, Issued and dispatched letters.

- 2. RUSA project reports are uploaded on the site of Project Monitoring System for verification of the RUSA office, Assam.
- 3. Progress reports of the works were sent to the RUSA office Assam time to time.

### **Quality of Works:**

- 1. The overall quality of the works in comparison to the funds allocated is satisfactory.

Equipment purchased under RUSA projects are excellent and examples of state of the art.

3. A large academic building of 488 sq. mtr. carpet area built under New Construction in G+2 structure having 10 nos. of classroom, 3 nos. of Hall classroom with 6 nos. of toilet units for both boys and girls. The contractor of the building has compromised the quality

of the work in some sections which has been noticed by the Project Monitoring Unit of the college and thus the college authority has forfeited the earnest money of the contractor as per norms. For constructing the building the college

invited E tender which has been praised by the RUSA office, Assam.

4. The renovation of the college under RUSA Projects in a planned way with limited

resources. It enhanced the quality of the classrooms, Conference Hall, auditorium, girls' hostel and academic building creating a positive academic
