STUDENT UNIFORM:

The students must put on the college uniform neatly and regularly as prescribed below: (Photos)

A. For Boys

- (i) White shirt with applique of college logo (to be supplied by the college) on the left pocket of the shirt (Full/Half sleeves).
- (ii) Black formal trouser.

N.B: Jeans & Skin-tight pants are strictly prohibited.

B. For Girls:

Girl students can wear either *Mekhela-chadar* or *Salwar Kameez* as per following details:

Mekhela Chadar:

- (i) *Muga* or white *mekhela*
- (ii) White blouse with an applique of college logo (to be supplied by the college) on the right sleeve
- (iii) White *chadar* with red border.

Salwar Kameez:

- (i) Loose knee length white *kameez* of round or square neck with sleeves of minimum five inches or full; a red strip of half inch stitched to the two side-cuttings of the *kameez*; the applique of the college logo (to be supplied by the college) should be stitched on the right sleeves.
- (ii) White *salwar* (*Patiwala* style of *Churidar* is prohibited)
- (iii) Red *Jaipuri dupatta* with white *bandhani* print (may be collected from the college office).

DISCIPLINE:

The Students Must Abide by the Following Rules and Regulations of the College:

- A.** No student shall be allowed to attend the classes without proper uniform.

- B.** Students must bring identity card every day.
- C.** Students must maintain discipline and obey the teachers inside the classroom as well as outside.
- D.** Students must not damage any college property.
- E.** Use of intoxicants, Tobacco, smoking etc. inside the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- F.** Ragging in all forms is totally prohibited within the college campus and its surroundings.
- G.** Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited, except in the Common Room on urgent need only.

Note: Violation of any one of these clauses is punishable. It shall lead to fine or expulsion.

ATTENDANCE:

Regular attendance in the class is compulsory. Students with attendance below 80% will not be allowed to appear in the final examinations.

LIBRARY:

A well-equipped library is housed in the first floor of the college administrative building. The library has garnered more than 30,000 text books & reference books. Besides these, the library is also enriched with a series of Encyclopedia, popular series, research project reports, dissertations etc. The college subscribes journals and newspapers of national and international repute. Computers with internet access facility in the library are also available. A spacious and well-furnished reading room is attached with the library and the students can have easy access to it during the college hours.

Each student is given non-transferable library card to borrow books from the library. A refundable library caution money of Rs. 300/- is charged from each student which is to be paid at the time of admission. The library is also open for general public and students of other institutions for two days (Wednesday & Saturday) in a week. The college provides book bank facility to the needy students. General public and outside students willing to access the library facility may contact Mr. Biman Chadra Das, Library in-charge of the college.

STUDENT ORIENTED ACTIVITIES:

A. COLLEGE MAGAZINE:

The college publishes an annual magazine with contributions from the students, teachers and employees of the college. Besides this, several departments have their own periodicals, wall magazines and newsletters.

There are separate common rooms, one each for boys and girls in the college premises.

E. CANTEEN FACILITY:

There is a canteen situated within the college campus where the students can have their refreshment at subsidized rate.

F. GYMNASIUM HALL:

There is a well-equipped multi-purpose gymnasium hall set up in 2012 where every student and employee can practice during the practice hour under the supervision of a trained instructor.
