Policy for Spot Admission into the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) for the Academic Session 2026–27

Admission Notice

The objective of Spot Admission is to fill vacant seats remaining after completion of all regular admission rounds in a fair, transparent, merit-based, and time-bound manner.

This policy shall apply to all FYUGP programmes offered by the institution for the academic session 2026–27.

Spot Admission shall be conducted under the supervision of the Principal/Director and the Admission Committee constituted by the institution.

Eligibility

A candidate shall be eligible to participate in **Spot Admission** only if:

1. The candidate has already registered through the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal (SAMARTH) for the session 2026-2027.
2. The candidates who have not registered in the portal for admission.
3. The candidate satisfies the eligibility criteria prescribed for the concerned programme and subject set by the college.
4. The candidate has not secured admission in the concerned programme in the institution through earlier admission rounds, or has formally cancelled such admission before participating in Spot Admission.
5. The candidate produces all required original documents for verification.

Registration for Spot Admission

1. Interested candidates must register for Spot Admission within **June 15 to June 17, 2026**
2. Registration will be conducted through:
 - Online SAMARTH platform
 - Physical reporting at the institution.
3. Mere registration shall not guarantee admission.

Conduct of Spot Admission

1. Admissions shall be offered strictly against notified vacancies on first-cum-first serve basis.
2. The decision of the Admission Committee regarding seat allocation shall be final.

Document Verification

Candidates must produce the following documents in **original** along with self-attested photocopies:

- SAMARTH Application Form
- Class X Admit Card/Marksheet/Certificate (proof of age)
- Class XII Mark Sheet and Pass Certificate
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- EWS Certificate (if applicable)
- Disability Certificate (if applicable)
- Gap Certificate/Affidavit (if applicable)
- Aadhaar Card or other Government-issued Photo ID (mandatory)
- Ration Cards (for availing Fee Waiver)
- Bank Passbook
- PAN Card
- Recent Passport-size Photographs

Failure to produce required documents may result in cancellation of candidature.

Fee Payment

1. Selected candidates of APL category and not availing Fee Waiver Scheme shall have to pay an **admission fee of 7180/-** (Seven Thousand One Hundred and Eighty) immediately or within the time specified by the institution.
2. For Fee waiver under income **upto 4 lacs** per annum, **Ration Card** of the parents/guardian in original must be produced.
3. Students availing Fee Waiver Scheme must produce the **Undertaking and Declaration Form** duly signed by parents/guardians.

Reservation Policy

Reservation of seats shall be governed by the prevailing policies of:

- Government of Assam;
- University/affiliating authority; and
- Applicable statutory provisions.

Unfilled reserved seats may be converted as per Government and University guidelines.


Cancellation of Admission


Admission may be cancelled if:

- Information furnished is found false;
- Documents are forged or manipulated;
- Eligibility conditions are not fulfilled;
- Any violation of institutional admission rules is detected.

Interpretation Clause

In matters not covered by this policy, the decision of the Principal/Director shall prevail, subject to the rules of the Government of Assam, the affiliating University, and the SAMARTH admission framework.
